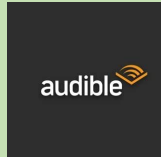




Family Resources for Distance Learning Morgan County Schools

Audible—Free streaming of stories as long as schools are closed! These are appropriate for all ages PK-Adult.

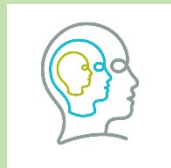
